

## GUIDE TO PREPARING A CHABURA

---

Thanks for agreeing to give the Chabura. This is a short guide that outlines what to do and the specific requirements involved.

You will receive a topic based on the week's Perokim from a member of the Daily Nach Team. If you have not received a topic, please contact us at [dailynach@gmail.com](mailto:dailynach@gmail.com). Please make a source sheet for all attendees. We will photocopy the sheet. We recommend that it should be text based, but most of the Chabura should be explained rather than read out. The Chabura may be recorded and the source sheet will be uploaded onto our website.

- **The Chabura should last between 20-25 minutes.**
- The source sheet should preferably be double sided to ensure there is sufficient content.
- **Please send the source sheet to [dailynach@gmail.com](mailto:dailynach@gmail.com) by Sunday of your allotted week (for the Boys school) or handed to Chaim Golker in Beis on Monday morning. We will photocopy the sheets for you.**
- In addition, please ensure we receive an email with the source sheet, so we can put it on our website (even if we have received a printed sheet to photocopy).
- The Chabura is for students from Year 7 to 6<sup>th</sup> form and therefore should be pitched at their level.

The text of the Source Sheets can be taken from a computer program, [www.hebrewbooks.org](http://www.hebrewbooks.org) or can be scanned from Seforim. We recommend using a range of sources including: Meforshim on the Possukim, Gemmoras and Halacha. The sources you bring depend on the topic you are giving and we are happy to help you find sources relevant to your topic. We recommend you attend or have a look at old Chabura source sheets to get an understanding what is required.
